BY THE NUMBERS

FY20

Meals served to seniors in the West Valley through our Senior Center and home delivered meals (HDM) programs. When our Senior Center was closed to the public due to COVID-19, many of our congregate clients shifted to our HDM program. In fact, **77%** of our meals were delivered through the HDM program.



Hours of financial coaching provided to women seeking financial independence for themselves and their families.

People served through our direct service and advocacy programs. In response to the killings of George Floyd, Breonna Taylor, Dion Johnson, and so many other Black Americans, and recognizing our responsibility as a convener of courageous conversations, we created a workshop entitled, *Racism: The Other Pandemic*, where participants examined our country's long history of structural and institutional racism and YWCA's commitment to racial justice and gender equity.





Members of hard to count communities - including seniors, low income families, women, and Native Americans - who received information and support on getting counted in the 2020 Census. The counting of these individuals contributes upwards of \$1,569,000 of federal funding towards Arizona for roads, schools, and much, much more.
